Budget allocated for the purchase of their current residence



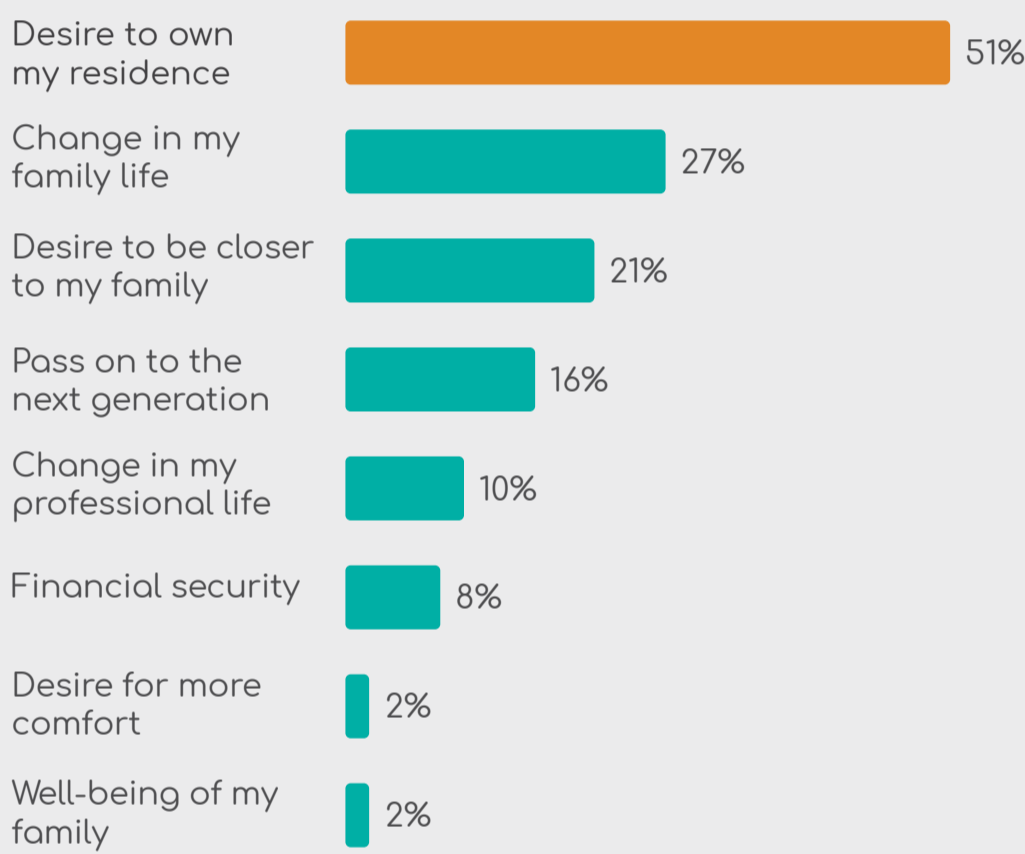

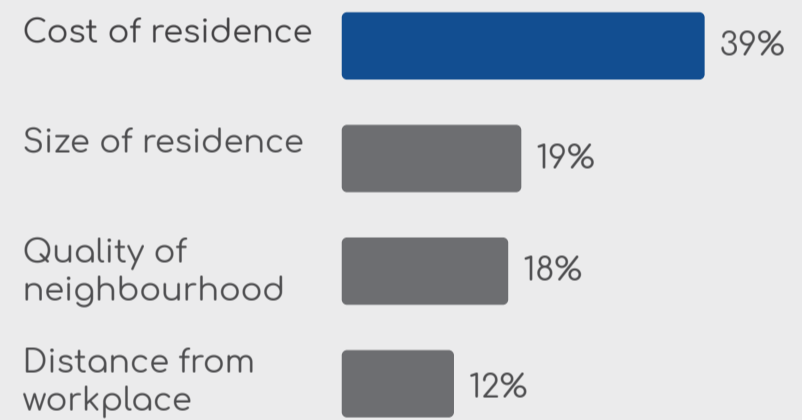

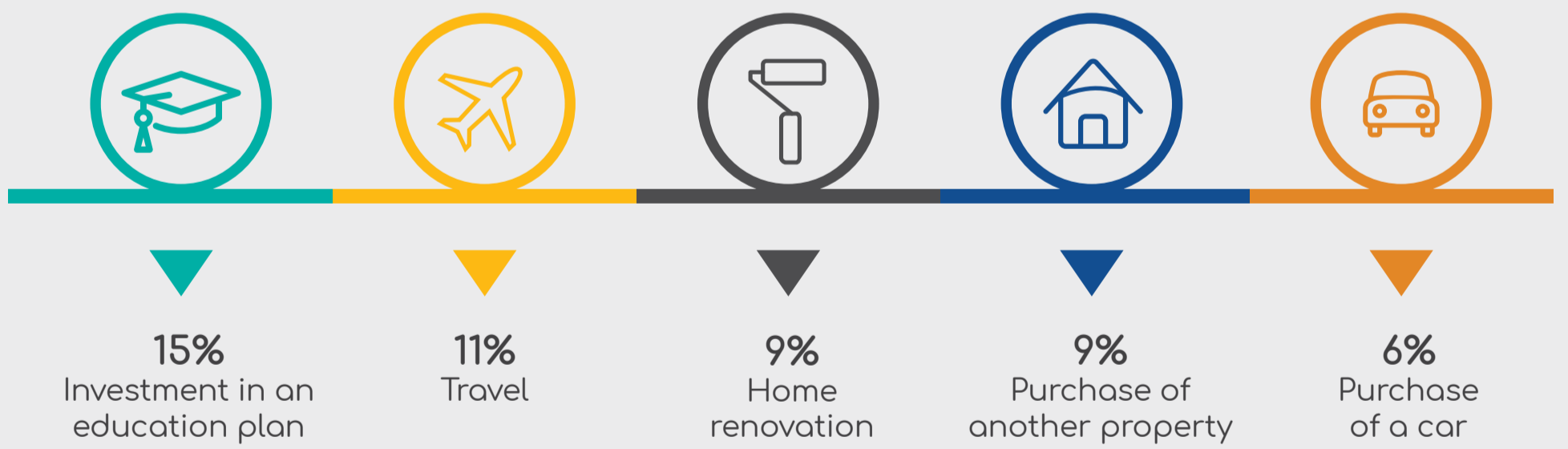


3 homeowners out of 10 were compelled to make trade-offs for the purchase of their current residence
